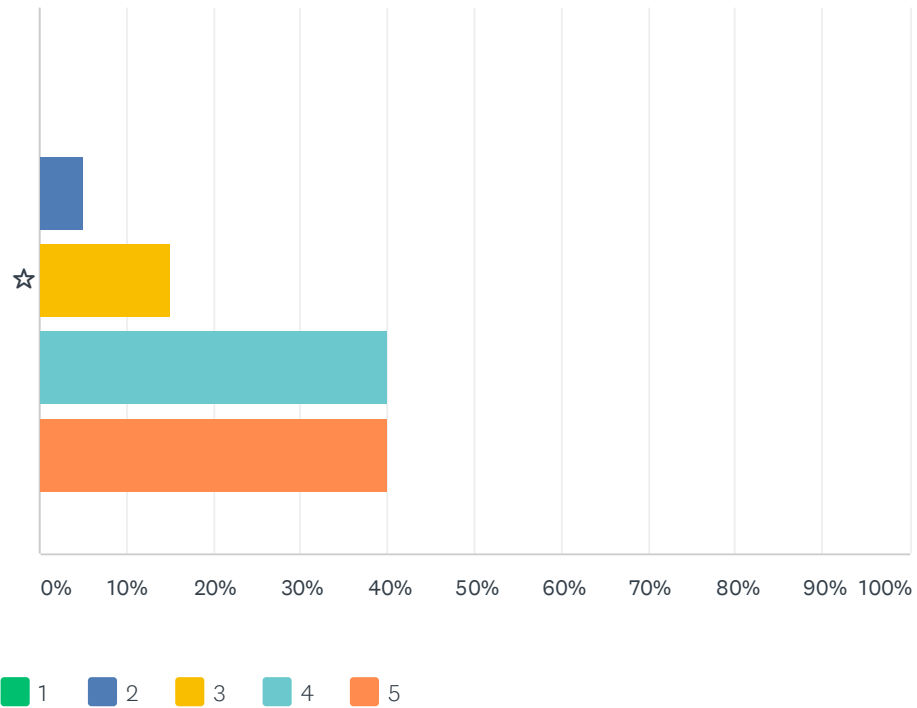


Q1 Overall, how would you rate the 2020 MAWB Annual Meeting?

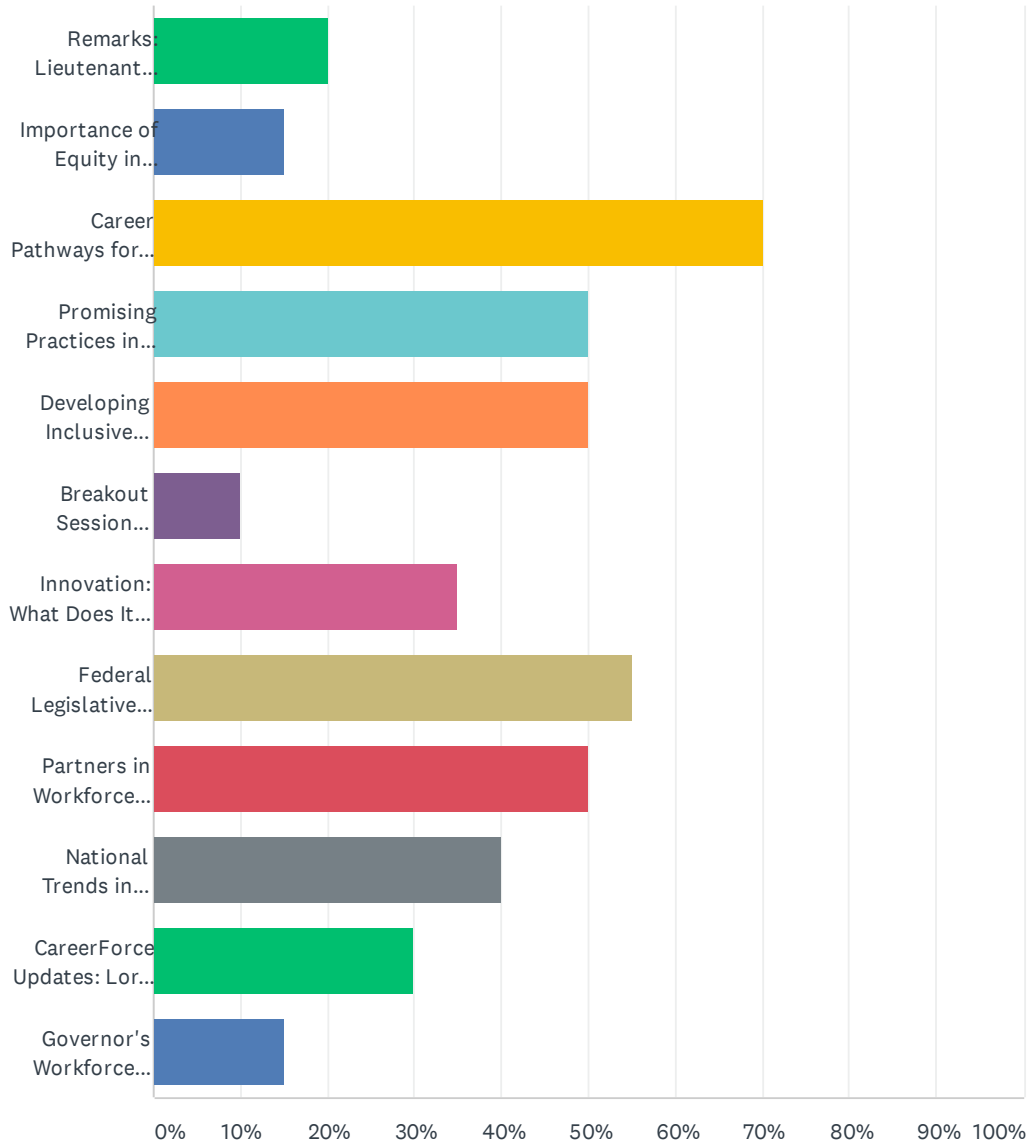

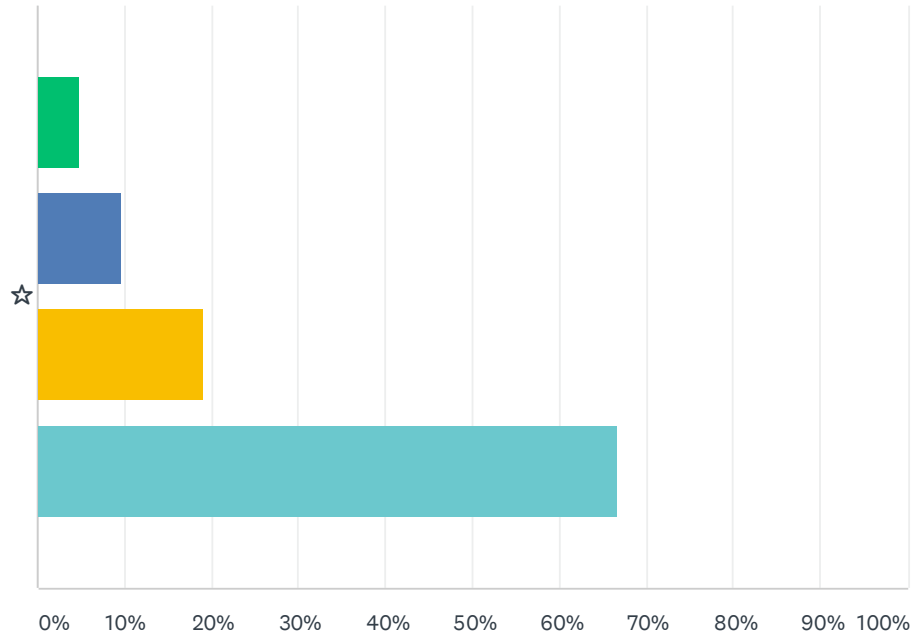

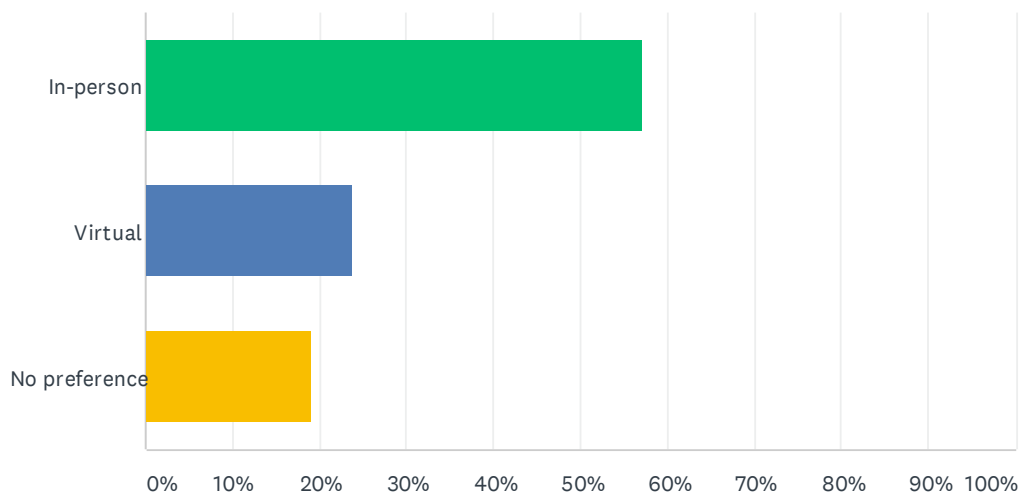
