- Full meetings of the Equity Committee will include a speaker, a data-driven presentation, and a report from each Task Group.

- The committee discussed setting a long-term goal for MAWB to embed equity in all committees and work plans.
- It was suggested that the January Operations Committee meeting include time for each local area to
 present one slide about successes and ongoing issues with equity in their local area.
