


- 12 regional public library systems

In-person visits are steadily decreasing as library users access digital resources.




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Books & More


In 2019, holdings are still mostly physical.

Digital Inclusion


Internet usage in public libraries saw a slight decline in 2019 overall.

The number of community meetings taking place in libraries almost doubled from 2015 to 2019.




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Partnerships & Possibilities
