Youth Data Elements Requested Annually

- Based on the original language in the 2021 DEED appropriations bill, the following data items are included:
 1. Total number of participants enrolled in training;
 2. Total number of participants who completed training;
 3. Total number of exited participants placed in employment;
 4. Total number of participants placed in post-secondary education;

Youth Data Elements Requested Annually

- Based on the original language in the 2021 DEED appropriations bill, the following data items are included (continued):
 5. Total number of participants placed in one of the following:
 - Occupation or vocational skill training;
 - Apprenticeship; or,
 - Military

Youth Data Elements Requested Annually

- Based on the original language in the 2021 DEED appropriations bill, the following data items are included (continued):
 6. Total number of exited participants who have returned to school;
 7. Total number of exited participants who earned academic credit or service learning credit for work-based learning or participation in work experience;

Youth Data Elements Requested Annually

- Based on the original language in the 2021 DEED appropriations bill, the following data items are included (continued):
 8. Total number of exited participants who have earned a HS Diploma or GED;
 9. Total number of exited participants who have earned a certificate or industry-recognized credential; and,

Youth Data Elements Requested Annually

- Based on the original language in the 2021 DEED appropriations bill, the following data items are included (continued):

10. Total number of exited participants who have completed and attained work-readiness skills training

Youth Data Elements Caveats

- Participants/exiters may earn multiple credentials during their time of participation, but these may not be counted until a later year if the metric is exiter-based.
- We presume “Returned to School” can be secondary school or post-secondary.
- Many new youth program participants enroll after the end of the school year; these individuals will impact outcomes if percentages are used for measurement.
