 - Julie Dincau provided updates, Minnesota will now offer two different high school equivalency tests, the GED and the HiSET test, will be rolled out in 6 months
 - Integrated education and training is being promoted by feds, combining training and basic education, trying to offer more trainings that include concurrent and contextual education and training
 - Racial equity grant going to SW ABE program, looking for possible subcontractors to work on racial equity
 - Adult ed competition next year, local boards will be asked to review applications.

- Art Larsen gave updates on Good Jobs Now Calls—continue to make calls, over 85k have been made. Staff are moving to more in-person services in 16 comprehensive centers. (Blaine Bloomington, Brainerd, Burnsville, Duluth, Hibbing, Mankato, Marshall, Minneapolis, Monticello, Rochester, St. Cloud, St. Paul, Thief River Falls, Winona, Woodbury)
- Job Search Appointment (In-Person, Phone, or Online)—can sign up for appointments via CareerForceMN.com, people who come in are given a COVID screening. Looking for more ways to market the appointments. Appts are being underutilized.
