## PY21 WIOA DW and Adult

- 2<sup>nd</sup> allotment paperwork sent to all WDAs.
- Qtr. Progress Report due Oct. 30<sup>th</sup> (Jul-Sep)
- Qtr. Program Expenditures
  - Keep an eye on your expenditures to ensure alignment with work plan.

### PY19 Reallocation

• Unspent WIOA DW and Adult funds will be reallocated in November. Please be on the lookout for communication from the team.

## Senior Community Service Employment Program

- Previously unresolved Findings with DOL is now resolved. Several policies will be posted in November for public comment period and go live in December.
- The optional special requests submitted with PY21 application to the DOL were approved (see attached documents):

## Retaining Employment and Talent after Injury/Illness Network (RETAIN)

- RETAIN demonstration project tests the impact of early intervention strategies on the stay at work/return
  to work outcomes of workers who have recently incurred a new injury or illness, or who recently
  experienced an exacerbation of an existing injury/illness that affects their ability to work.

The Minnesota Tech Training Pilot Project Grantees will begin programming this month. This is a new program within ACP and the team is excited to provide an additional training opportunity to communities throughout the state.

Thank you for all the great submissions for the Southeast Asian Economic Relief Grant, African Immigrant Community Economic Relief Grant, On-Ramp to Career Pathways, Bridge to Career Pathways, Individual Training Pathway, WESA, and Adult Support Services RFPs. All are now closed, and we expect notification to applicants early to mid-November.

The Getting to Work and Internationally Trained Professionals RFPs are still open and accepting applications through November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. In addition, the Targeted Community Capital Project RFP was released on Friday October 22<sup>nd</sup>. This grant will award \$18 million to non-profits organizations and government entities within Minnesota for capital projects. Projects utilizing these funds must result in providing, increasing, and/or expanding access to economic development, education or workforce development programs or services to underserved communities or economically disadvantaged persons or groups.

## Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA)

#### Reversion 2021

On July 1, 2021, the TAA Program reverted to a modified version of the Trade Reform Act of 2002. Any workers covered under a Petition for Trade Adjustment Assistance filed on or after July 1, 2021, would be covered by this modified version. Current customers and people who are eligible under an older petition continue to receive the benefits under the appropriate law of their petition. Nearly all of our current customers are covered by 2015 Law and their services/benefits will <u>not</u> change.

One of the major changes under Reversion 2021 is that Reemployment Trade Adjustment Assistance (RTAA) is now Alternative Trade Adjustment Assistance (ATAA) and it's truly an "Alternative" to training.

- Alternative Trade Adjustment Assistance: Wage subsidy for up to 2 years available to workers age 50 or
  over who are reemployed full-time within 26 weeks of separation at annual wages of \$50,000 or less, and
  who do not attend TAA-funded training, or receive TRA or Job Search Allowance.
- Once a worker receives TRA or a job search allowance, or is enrolled in training (approved and to begin within 30 days), they are ineligible for ATAA.
- ATAA cannot be combined with OJT
- ATAA can be combined with Relocation Allowance
