### RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT FOR CROSS-BORDER

#### Purpose

This agreement is entered into between states to provide the exchange of information pertaining to the transfer of an SCSEP participant. Both the requesting and accepting regions should be in full agreement and maintain written communications regarding the circumstances involved in the transfer of the SCSEP participant.

#### Provisions

This agreement shall commence on the date signed and remain valid until such time either party deems it necessary to terminate and/or modify said agreement. All modifications to this agreement shall be made in writing. Either party may terminate this agreement with 30 days written notice.

Each state is responsible for the accuracy and verification of information shared relative to serving its participants. Both the requesting and accepting regions should be in full agreement and maintain written communications regarding the circumstances involved in the transfer of the SCSEP participant.

The State of Minnesota and the State of Wisconsin will share confidential client data for transfer purposes. The two states agree to work on an agreement to share client data in accordance with each state's respective data practices laws.
