- a consortium or coalition of the agencies, organizations, institutions, libraries, or authorities described above;
- a partnership between an employer and an entity described above; and
- Any other entity that has demonstrated effectiveness in serving eligible individuals.

Applications due date: March 8, 2022, by 3:30 p.m. Central Standard Time

This is a multiyear grant, lasting three years. Up to \$150,00 per year.

Federal Adult Education Competition

Applications due date: March 25, 2022 by 3:30 p.m. Central Standard Time

This is a multiyear grant, lasting six years, the authorization period of the federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA).
