The Good Jobs Now Outreach calls have now ended and all initial calls are conducted by RESEA staff. Employment Services staff are the follow-up to those calls through a referral process. Similar to past processes, all UI applicants who are still requesting benefits will receive an another 3-week follow-up call from ES staff to offer additional assistance if needed.

In the first week of this new process, we received 419 referrals. By comparison, towards the height of the Outreach calls in August, we had made over 1,700 calls in one week. Much of this can be attributed to the lower number of UI Applicants, but the new process also screens out the vast majority of those who have recently returned to work.
