## **DEED Updates**

- Veterans Services: Veterans Services staff can now access four correctional facilities as part of a pilot project to provide services to justice-involved individuals. The 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Veterans Career Fair will be held in May, and the annual Hire a Veteran Month will be moved from July to May this year, following approval from the Governor. DEED will be submitting an action plan to become a Yellow Ribbon state agency.
