Committee resources

- M State's proposed biennium budget has had two readings with the Board of Trustees. The
 request is for \$350 million over the biennium. See the <u>Board materials</u> beginning on page 80 for
 the full proposal. Note, this proposal has NOT yet been approved.
- <u>FastForward Virginia</u>: short-term training program for high-demand industries, offered locally through community colleges.
- There are now eight Business Engagement Specialists with VRS; they have recently hired three new people to the team.
- DEED's Vocational Rehabilitation Services Program was recently <u>awarded \$13 million from the</u> federal Disability Innovation Fund Grant
- Exploring Potential Interests and Careers (EPIC) was held in October and brought in 4,200 students to explore careers.
- Related program <u>EPIC for Influencers</u>, designed for parents/guardians/supportive adults, is coming up on November 15th
- Ramsey County recently partnered with the St. Paul Area Chamber to offer <u>Career Connect Day</u> at the Saint Paul RiverCentre
- Washington County recently held their <u>Workforce and Economic Development Summit</u> in Woodbury
- <u>HireVets.gov Medallion Program</u> recognition program for employers who invest in hiring, recruiting, and retaining veterans as employees
