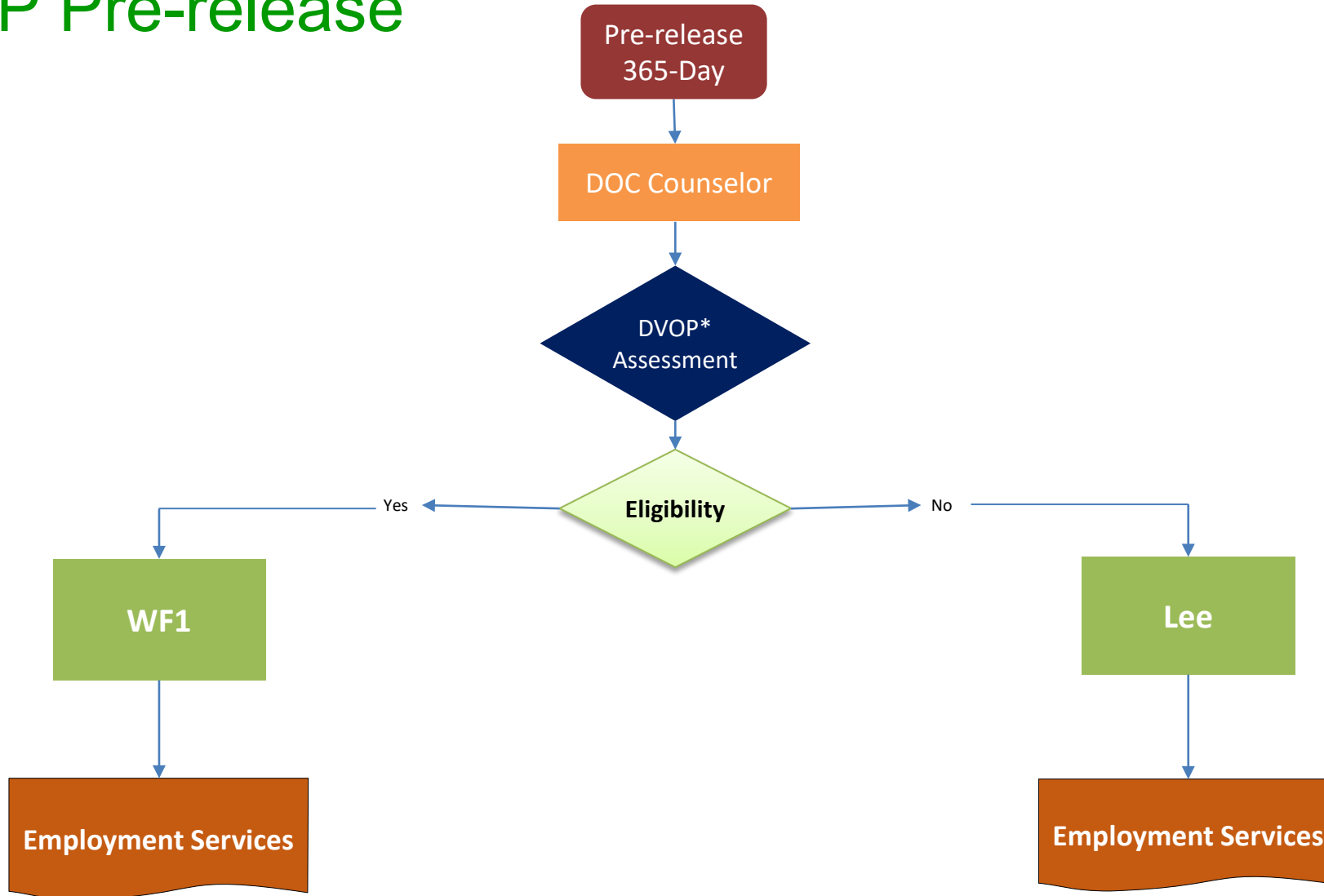

# Purpose

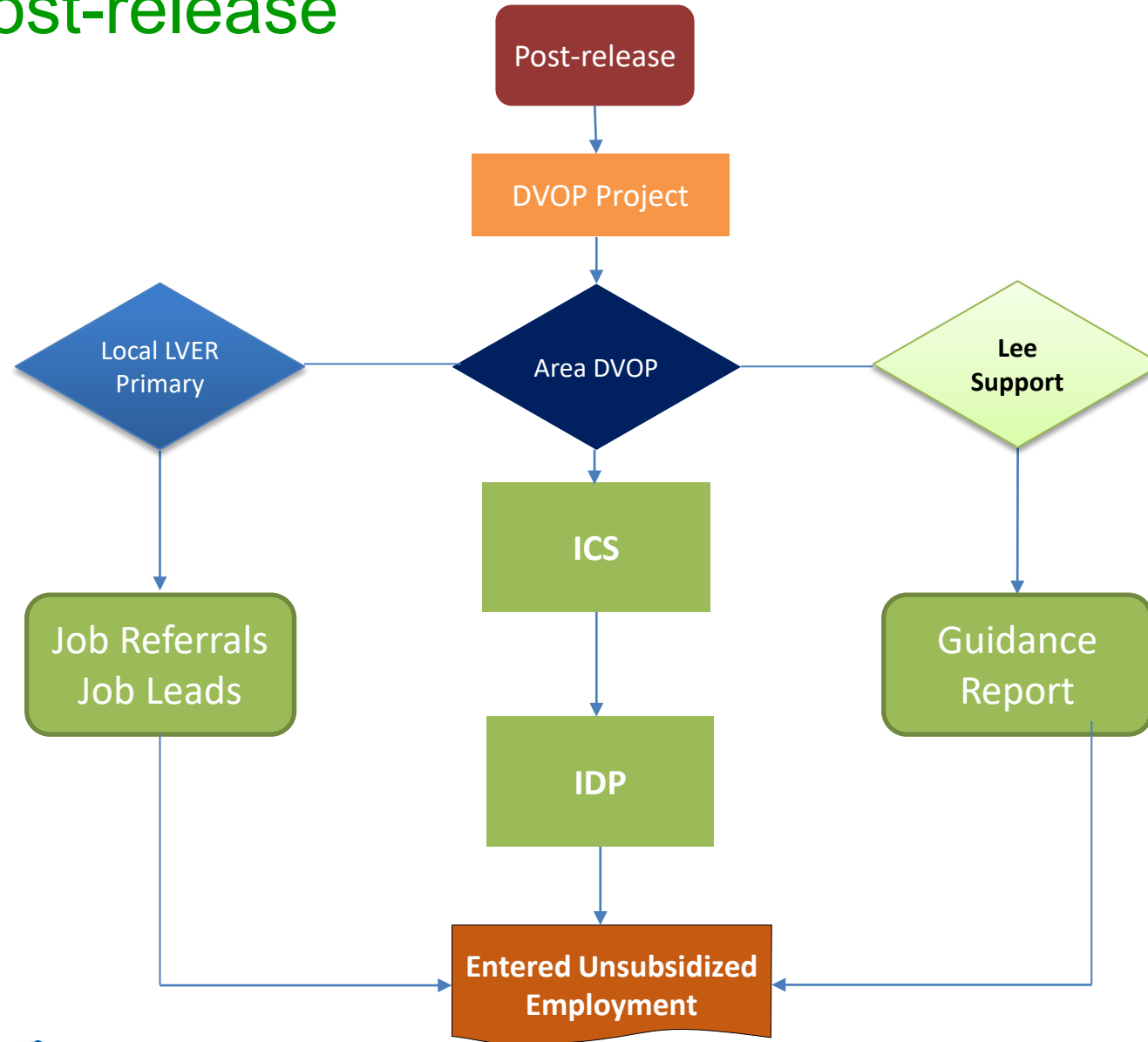
## DEED Vets and DOC signed Interagency on May 2022

- Allow access to DEED Vet staff to access DOC facilities
- To provide individualized career services (ICS) to the Justice-Involved Veterans (JIV) within the State of MN Department of Corrections (DOC) facilities.
- The goal is to establish a strong connection between pre-and post-release employment services for JIV.
- Through timely and effective services, JIV will be empowered to overcome barriers and to become “job-ready” when they are released on probation or parole. This initiative will lessen recidivism and bolster community reintegration.
