- 6. In partnership with Minnesota's Department of Human Services, MCCD recently launched the <u>Home and Community Based Services Workforce Development cooperatives grant program</u>. Ten grants are available to qualifying applicants and selected groups will receive up to a total of \$162,000, split over two years along with expert advising to guide them through the process of establishing a cooperative business. The purpose of the program is to help direct care / direct support professionals (such as CNAs or home health aides) establish employee-owned cooperative home and community-based services businesses (such as a residential group home or an in-home care business). The grant can also be used to transition an existing home and community-based services business to an employee-owned cooperative. <u>See also the DHS page on the same program</u>.
