The committee members discussed strategies for increasing attendance at job fairs. Ideas included:

- Holding job fairs on college campuses so that students walk through on their way to another class.
- Marketing techniques such as newspaper, local radio, billboards, and Facebook ads were discussed. Each type of outreach seemed to have varying levels of impact based on the area; the technique that worked best for some areas didn't work well for others.
- The Minneapolis Teen Job Fair has a Youth Coordinating Board youth are paid to help market the event. This has made a positive impact for increasing turnout.
- Redwood and Kandiyohi counties are cohosting their third virtual-only career fair on May 18th,
 2023. They will have this event open longer during the day than the past two years.
- Some areas use Google Search ads, which are particularly effective over the weekend as people search for jobs.
