

SNAP E&T Time Limits Training

Training Overview:

In May, the Department of Human Services will host time limits training for SNAP E&T providers across the state. Training will include information about:

- Who is a Time-limited Recipient (TLR)?
- How to know if a participant is time-limited
- Ways TLR can meet work requirements
- Hour tracking and how to know when tracking is necessary
- Best practices for serving time-limited SNAP recipients
- Best practices for communicating with counties and tribes when serving time-limited recipients

Three identical sessions will be held. Staff should attend only one of the three sessions.

Who Should Attend:

This training is intended for all SNAP E&T providers, including DEED contracted, DHS contracted, county or tribal contracted, and county or tribal in-house. Staff working directly with SNAP E&T participants, and their direct supervisors should attend.

This training is not intended for county or tribal eligibility staff or SNAP Outreach staff and registration will be limited to SNAP E&T providers only. Time-limited recipient training for eligibility staff will be offered in June as a web-based training.
