#### **Jobseekers Services Committee**

5/24/23

#### **General Overview**

- Budget completed on time!
- DFL Trifecta worked with a \$17.5B surplus—mostly one-time money
- Record 6,000 bills introduced

### **MAWB Priorities**

- Increase Minnesota Youth Program Funding
- Business Services
- Adults with high barriers to employment
- Protect Workforce Development Fund

### **Final Jobs Bill**

- \$10M Drive for Five Program each year (technology, labor, caring professions, manufacturing, and educational and professional services)
  - Trade associations and chambers
  - Business services reps
- \$25M Targeted Population Workforce Program each year
  - Employment and training grants for small CBOs serving diverse or low-income communities
  - Includes DEI training for businesses
- \$10M Digital Tools
- \$8.5M Minnesota Youth Program each year
- Office of New Americans
- Many direct allocations
- Level funded: P2P and RC3

## **Other Items Passed**

- North Star Promise—free tuition for families making less than 80k
- \$100M for Broadband
- \$200M for Human Services Systems Modernization
- Increased investments in childcare
- Cannabis legalization
- Paid Family and Medical Leave

## What's Next?

- DEED will be working on executing grants
- Opportunities for local boards:
  - Drive for Five
  - Partnering with Chambers/Trade Associations for job placement
  - Partnering with CBOs on Targeted Populations
  - Working with DEED on BSR roles
