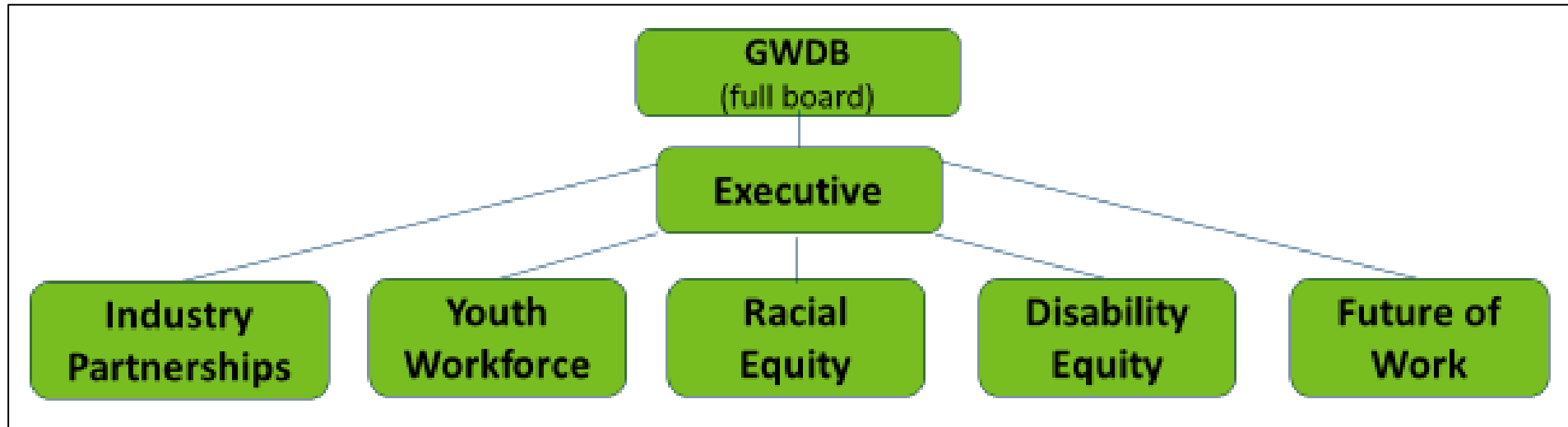

Goals for the GWDB

- Support the expansion of equitable and inclusive career pathways for all Minnesotans
- Understand current and future workforce needs across industries and occupations
- Identify gaps in service for occupations, populations, wraparound supports, etc.
- Strategically align funding and services to demands
- Incorporate strategies, priorities and policies identified by the GWDB to workforce programs across DEED
- Establish a unified workforce strategy across relevant agencies
- Analyze and recommend workforce development policies to the governor and legislature toward talent development, resource alignment and system effectiveness

GWDB Committee Structure



Goal: Better leverage the GWDB and its members to support a more aligned workforce system that meets the needs of career seekers and employers statewide. We'll do this by:

- Reimagining our committee structure to meet the moment & current needs
- Involving more state agency/system partners in the GWDB's work
- Elevating voices, perspectives of partners from outside of government
- Increasing focus on specific sectors/industries with greatest potential for MN's economy

Workforce Summit

 - Preparing for a Changing Economy – a 5-year view on in-demand occupations and changing demographics

- Invite-only afternoon session for Local Workforce Development Areas to start Local and Regional Planning Process, reflecting on how their local areas contribute to the One Minnesota Vision

WIOA State Plan Timeline

- August: Convene WIOA Program Administrators to finalize timeline, roles, and responsibilities
- August: DEED Guidance issued for State, Regional and Local Plans
- November 8: Due date for first drafts of each of the state plan sections
- By the end of December 2023: State, regional and local plan submitted to GWDB Executive Committee and Agency Senior Leaders for review
- January 15, 2024: Plan submitted for Governor's Review and posted for Public Comment
- January 15-February 15, 2024: Staff review public comments and feedback from Governor's Office
- February 17-28, 2024: Incorporate any final changes from Governor's Office or Public Comment
- February, 2024: Final review by the GWDB Executive Committee
- March 6, 2024: Full GWDB Meeting to Approve Plan
- March 15, 2024: WIOA 2024-2027 State Plan submitted to US DOL

WIOA Local Plan Timeline

- August – DEED Guidance issued for State, Regional and Local Plans
- September 20 – Planning meeting the afternoon of the Workforce Summit
- November 10 – Share first draft of state plans with local and regional planning staff
- December 1 – First draft of all Regional and Local Plans due
- Dec 1 – Dec 22: DEED staff review local and regional plans, provide updates or approval
- By the end of December 2023: State, regional and local plans submitted to GWDB Executive Committee and Agency Senior Leaders for review.

Vision: One Minnesota Vision for Workforce Development, building an inclusive and equitable workforce system around shared goals and priorities

WIOA State Plan Goals:

- Improve interagency coordination and alignment
- Build employer-led industry-sector partnerships focused on closing gaps in participation and representation based on race, disability, gender, and age
- Create a more inclusive, equitable and proactive workforce system to serve all Minnesotans

2024-2027 WIOA State Plan Strategies:

- Targeted Populations
- GWDB Committees (Executive, Industry Partnerships, Youth Programs, Racial Equity, Disability Equity, Future of Work)

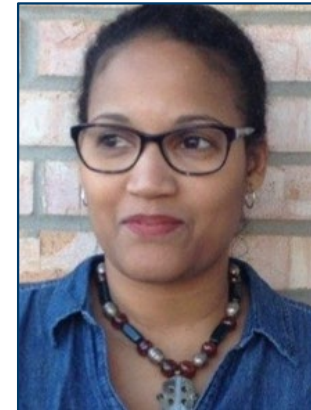
