## SNAP E&T Updates from the State of Minnesota

- 1. **Management Evaluation:** The SNAP and SNAP E&T Management Evaluation was completed. We have not received our final report yet.
- 2. **State Plan Submission:** The SNAP E&T State Plan and request for additional funds was submitted. We have not received approval yet, but we will be notifying all counties and tribes when that is approved.
- SNAP E&T Annual Meeting: SNAP E&T Team is planning and preparing for the Annual SNAP E&T Provider meeting beginning on Monday, October 9<sup>th</sup>.

## 4. Screening & Referral

The new screening and referral process is being implemented 10/1/23. Eligibility was trained on this process at the County and Tribal Nations meeting on 9/20/23. The presentation will be available on SIR, and will also be added as a web-based training on Trainlink in the near future. Workers will be using the provider map (mentioned in #4) to create a handout/referral form for SNAP recipients that want to be referred to SNAP E&T. Instructions for how to do this are included in the training. Workers will also see a list of additional providers in their area in the MAXIS referral pop-up screen, and workers will be able to select a provider in their area. It will be important for eligibility to understand and know more about the SNAP E&T providers in their area.

The A resource for SNAP E&T is the SNAP E&T Provider Map. The SNAP E&T Provider Map is an interactive map that identifies SNAP E&T providers by county and the types of supportive services and SNAP E&T support offered.
