When you attend a Career Fair/ Job Fair/ Hiring Event

- 1. You are not there to pick up swag.
- 2. This is a networking opportunity.
 - You won't get a job at the event, and if they are offering jobs on the spot, it might not be a job you want.
- 3. Ask the business what brings them to the event.
 - Then listen to what they say. If they have a need that you can fill talk about how you have solved that in the past without giving too much information.
- 4. The recruiters at the event know recruiters from other companies. Be rememberable and referable. Practice your introduction with people who you already know and trust, plus give them permission to be honest with their feedback.
- 5. Have a business/ networking card. With...
 - A. Your name.
 - B. The job title you are looking for.
 - C. Your mobile phone number.
 - D. Your email address.
 - E. Your LinkedIn URL.
 These should present a professional image.
- 6. Have five to ten copies of your résumé.
- 7. Dress in a business professional manner, the rule of thumb is one step above the job you are looking to achieve.
- 8. Have a "Wingman" someone to lookout for you to let you know about your appearance and demeanor.
