

Apprenticeship Minnesota Funding

- Apprenticeship Minnesota is funded by a \$2.7 million state appropriation
 - \$1.7 million supports the division
 - \$1 million awarded through LEAP grants
- Apprenticeship Minnesota applies for federal additional grant funding as it is available
- Nearly all registered apprenticeship programs are self-funded



Labor Education Advancement Program

- Facilitate the recruitment and retention of people of color, Indigenous people and women in registered apprenticeship programs
- Community-Based Organizations, Nonprofits, and Tribal Governments
- \$1 million annually
- RFP will open in March 2025

Clean Economy Occupations Grant

- Goal is to grow apprenticeship in clean economy occupations
- Eligible applicants: Registered Apprenticeship Programs in Minnesota
- \$3 million available
- \$200,000 maximum award
- RFP is currently open; rolling application until funds are spent.

Supportive Services Funding

Funding awarded to the sponsor

- \$150,000 total available
- Reimbursement
- Can support new apprentices and retention of current apprentices
- RFP available in early April
 - Rolling application until funds are spent

• Eligible Expenses

- Childcare
- Tools, work clothing, or equipment required to train for a job
- Application fees and other costs of apprenticeship or required pre-employment training
- Transportation
- DLI has a grant supportive services policy
 - State funding policies require expenditures follow the same rules required for all state contracts and expenditures.
