Adult Education is Title II of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

2023-2024 WIOA Title II Statewide Performance Reports

The *Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act* (WIOA) annual performance reports for program year (PY) 2023–24 are now available. PY 2023–24 is the eighth year states reported data under the WIOA performance accountability provisions. The statewide performance reports for programs authorized in each state and outlying area under the *Adult Education and Family Literacy Act* (AEFLA), title II of WIOA, the AEFLA national summary report, and links to performance information for our WIOA partner programs can be found at [WIOA Title II Statewide Performance Reports for Program Year 2023–24](#)

The national adult education program enrolled 1,288,367 participants in PY2023–24. That represents an annual increase of 15 percent. With 167,598 additional participants in PY2023–24, the AEFLA program achieved the largest consecutive enrollment growth of all WIOA core programs combined. Key highlights from PY2023–24 data for the AEFLA program include:

- National AEFLA program performance increased for median quarterly earnings, credential attainment, and measurable skill gains, while decreasing for employment in the second and fourth quarters.
- Adult education participants achieved 689,321 measurable skill gains.
- AEFLA programs enrolled 327,444 youth participants between the ages of 16 and 24, representing an 11 percent increase over the previous year’s enrollment. With 33,360 additional students, youth enrollment accounts for 25 percent of AEFLA program participants.
- AEFLA enrollment in corrections education increased by 8,104 participants (8 percent) in PY 2023–24.

Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE)
